ITE & Deeptech Track

This track encompassed **15 sessions** over the three-day conference, exploring diverse topics within **IT, Electronics, and Deeptech**. Day 1 featured a profound session on the evolving landscape of Global Capability Centres in India, while the subsequent session delved into the impact of Artificial Intelligence across the tech landscape.

Second part of the day included focused session on '**Electronics Industry- the backbone of India's Digital economy**' followed by a session exploring technologies, policies and investments, to make India a Semiconductor Nation.

Biotech Track

The theme for the Biotech segment in BTS 2023, '**BioNexa Bengaluru: Biotech Brilliance Unleashed**', featured 13 focused sessions led by global experts. The track commenced with a three-part Bio-Manufacturing session, including a Keynote by **Dr. Rajesh Gokhale**, Secretary, Department of Biotechnology, Government of India. He outlined the initiatives under the Bharat Biomanufacturing Initiative. The subsequent session, '**BioTechnology for a Fossil Carbon-free Future**', highlighted innovative bio-solutions for reducing carbon footprint. The series continued with '**Synthetic Biology and Next-gen Biotechnology**', exploring industry advancements and applications in healthcare, agriculture, and manufacturing.



Day 1

Concluded with a session on '**Sustainable Food** and **Agri-Systems**', addressing plant biotech for climate adaptation and molecular breeding for improved crop-productivity.

Day 2 of the Biotech Track opened with the much-awaited Fireside Chat session conducted by **Dr. Kiran Mazumdar-Shaw**, Executive Chairperson – Biocon Limited, & Chairperson, Vision Group on Biotechnology, Govt. of Karnataka with Nobel Laureate **Dr. H. Robert Horvitz**. This was followed by an invigorating Panel on Preventing Tomorrow's Illnesses which explored how cutting edge biotech is reshaping the future of Healthcare. Subsequent sessions covered '**Keeping Epidemics at Bay**', Bio investments, the role of capital in fostering innovation, growth, and Skill Development trends in the Biotech sector. Day 2 concluded with a session on '**Cell & Gene Therapy**', providing insights into the latest advancements.



Day 3 of the Biotech Track commenced with a session about the **Draft Biotech Policy** which was released during the Inauguration of BTS 2023. The final session, '**Biotech Future Forward**', delved into cutting-edge innovations and trends reshaping the biotech sector.

Startup Track

Day 1 of the Startup Track opened with a focused session on '**Digital Public Goods**' and explored the trends, challenges and opportunities through two panels. This was followed by another focused session on '**Journey from Ideas to IPO**'. Through keynote talks, a Masterclass and Panel Discussions, this session provided a unique opportunity for delegates to hear from Founders and offered real-world inspiration.



Day 2 centered on emerging technologies, featuring sessions such as '**Future of Quantum Computing**,' '**Rapid Evolution of Gen AI**,' and discussions on **Fintech**, **AgriFintech**, and **Agri 4.0**.



Day 3 commenced with an exploration of opportunities in tourism and the transformative influence of technologies on the sector. This was followed by a session on **Assistive Technology**, covering diverse devices, software, and services. The agenda continued with a session spotlighting Karnataka's technology landscape '**Beyond Bengaluru**,' and the track concluded with a session focused on **Startup Ecosystem** Enablers.




India-USA Tech Conclave





Chandrayaan 3 Mission

In the course of the Hon'ble Chief Minister's dialogue with Industry CEOs, the noteworthy contribution of **SMEs** to the **Chandrayaan 3** Mission was discussed and highly commended. Following the guidance of the Hon'ble CM, it was decided that BTS 2023 will feature a dedicated pavilion by **ISRO**, spotlighting the Chandrayaan Mission. This pavilion also showcased the significant involvement of Industry and SMEs in both the Chandrayaan Mission and other key initiatives of ISRO.



The ISRO-Industry pavilion was housed in a special dome structure and was a major highlight of BTS Expo. The ISRO Pavilion, for the first time, showcased a 1:1 scale model of **Chandrayaan** Module including the technology and mission covering indigenous Lander Module (LM), Propulsion Module (PM) and a Rover along with Launch vehicles and other systems.

In the same pavilion **Industry & SMEs** that contributed to Chandrayaan Mission as well as other Missions & Programmes showcased their products & technologies. The pavilion attracted enormous interest among visitors, with ISRO officials providing detailed information on the Chandrayaan -3 mission as well as other space and outer space programs of ISRO.

START-UP PRODUCT / SOLUTIONS LAUNCH

Shri Priyank Kharge, Hon'ble Minister for Electronics, IT, Bt, RDPR, GoK also launched **37** ground-breaking products and solutions developed by startups. The array of Products and solutions launched spanned a diverse range of sectors, including **IT/ITeS, Agritech, Medtech, Healthcare, Cleantech, AI, DeepTech, Blockchain, IoT, Cybersecurity, Environment Tech, AVGC** and **ESDM**. Notably, among the **37** startups, **9** are led by **women**, underscoring the inclusive and diverse nature of Karnataka's startup ecosystem. Majority of these startups flourished within GoK-supported incubators, such as Innovation Hubs, Centres of Excellence (CoEs) and Technology Business Incubators (TBIs) and anchored by **C-CAMP, NASSCOM, Jain Incubation Centre, Deshpande Startups, and CoE- Cybersecurity**.

The Annual **STPI IT Export Awards** were presented to high-achieving IT companies from Karnataka's IT sector, for their performance in the 2022-23 financial year. The prestigious **IT Ratna of Karnataka** was awarded to **Infosys** and **Intel**. Some of the other Awards presented include **IT Pride of Karnataka**; High Growth in **IT/ITES Exports- Karnataka**; Best Performers in Tier II & Tier III Region, Electronic Hardware; Exports per Employee and Employment; Highest New Jobs Creator; Highest per Employee and Highest Growth in Women Employment. In total, **43 awards** were presented to the deserving winners during the ceremony.






2) How would you rate the event's waste management practices at BTS2023?
